My name is Monica*. I have recently become homeless and jobless, am 20 weeks pregnant, and have an eleven-year-old. We are staying in a shelter right now. I was referred to you by Council for the Homeless and am inquiring about anything that might be available for me and my kids. I have never been this low or needed this much help. I literally have nothing. I'm not sure what resources would be available to me but I was told I could get some basic help through you guys. If so, I'd sincerely appreciate it. Please advise on any next steps I should take. Thank you.

Because of YOU, we were able to give Monica a car seat, large, colorful, layette gift bag, a Pac 'n Play crib and a stroller.

My name is Sophie* and I work in the jail re-entry program. I have a participant who is currently incarcerated and is 7-months pregnant. She gets out soon and is in need of an infant car seat. My co-worker referred me to you. Is this something you can help with? She does not have any money. Thank You. [CVAB/Reach Too peer mentors help people seeking recovery from addiction.]

You helped us provide not only a car seat but a big layette, bassinet and vibrating bouncy seat.

Graciela is a pregnant teen.* I am working with her in school to help her prepare for the arrival of her baby. She told me that one thing she really needs but doesn't have the resources to purchase is a car seat. After asking a few of the community and young parent support people within the school district, someone recommended Babies in Need. Is this something your group is able to help with? Thanks for any help or suggestions you can provide. [Vancouver School EL Specialist]

You bet! A car seat and more. The word about Babies in Need continues to spread among mothers and caseworkers.

Having these for her daughters gave her hope for discharge and hope that her daughter who was critically ill will survive. Thank you for touching so many lives in a good way.

Babies in Need delivers supplies to hospital birth centers every week. After making a fast delivery before a discharge, we received this email: *WOW!! You guys are amazing. Excellent service. 10 out of 10.*
