OUR DIAPER BANK REOPENED IN JANUARY

We were only closed for a few months and then sprang back to life with your help, a partnership with the Battle Ground Adventist Diaper Bank, a grant from the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, a benefit Piano Concert by Jordan Nylander of St. Lukes~San Lucas Episcopal Church, and donations from faithful local churches.

1 in 2 U.S. families struggles with diaper need. Babies without clean diapers are exposed to more potential health risks and less likely to be accepted at daycare, leaving parents unable to attend work.

A diaper bank mom ~ Hello! Thank you very much for helping with diapers and wipes! And for clothes! May God bless you and give you strength and health. We love your team!

Two new foster moms ~ One had an emergency placement of a 9-month-old. The other was adopting a special needs infant whose biological mother had just died. Both moms had to gather expensive essentials in a hurry. They were thankful to be able to get both diapers and clothes at our diaper bank. They are "on the front lines" and we're glad we can help.

CAR SEATS FOR HOMELESS AND REFUGEE FAMILIES

Family Promise provides shelter and case management to families in crisis, and stabilization programs once they have secured housing to ensure they remain independent. We provide them with car seats and booster seats. Many of these children have never had a car seat.

Lutheran Community Services Northwest prepares for the arrival of refugee families, meets them at the airport, and over several years equips them with skills, resources and support they need to live fulfilling, productive lives. Babies in Need is honored to have given layettes, diapers, clothing and 102 car seats to refugees from a dozen countries around the globe since 2022.
